USA Churches Started and Churches Restarted

Happy New Year to you, our supporters and prayer partners. Our theme for the USA Division of BIMI and Reseeding America for 2024 is "Bringing the Gospel Light to a Needy Nation." We remain convinced that the way to save our needy nation is to proclaim the Gospel from coast to coast. This can only be accomplished on an ongoing basis as we see new churches planted and churches in decline restarted.

Speaking of churches that are being planted and churches restarted, the David Sterling family with the Reseeding America Ministry has just launched West Valley Baptist Church in the West Flathead Valley near Kalispell, Montana. This missionary family came back to America due to the conflict in Ukraine after serving the Lord for 23 years in the Siberian region of Russia.

Another missionary family affected by the war in Ukraine is the Tony Hess family. Tony and Dawn and their family served in the Crimean region of Ukraine for over 20 years. They are presently serving with the Reseeding America Ministry and are restarting Fellowship Bible Baptist Church in Wattsburg, Pennsylvania. We will be in Wattsburg in April to assist them with this church restart. Please pray for these families.

A New Year of Ministry Starts in the West
