We pray that this prayer letter will find you rejoicing in the Lord and in the many blessings He brings daily into our lives. Rejoice with us for the wonderful work the Lord of the harvest continues to do as we endeavor to give the gospel of Jesus to the "millions untold still untold" in Brazil.

I recently arrived here in the U.S. in January and still plan to visit a few of our supporting churches through the end of April. It is going to be a special blessing to renew acquaintance with the brethren in churches that I have not visited for many years. As I had the opportunity to visit some churches, I have already seen souls saved and even some Christians dedicating their lives to serve the Lord.

The new Brazilian president, a staunched socialist, has vowed that he is going to impose the radical socialist agenda (gender ideology and so many other ungodly proposals) upon all branches of the educational system in Brazil, aiming primarily at our preschool children.

We have already had several conservative parents, though not Christians yet, coming over to our Christian School and asking us to allow their children to attend our school. What a tremendous opportunity to sow the gospel seed! The gracious God has already used our school as an instrument for the salvation of well over 200 students. Just recently, **Mr. Anderson** and his wife, **Ana Paula**, the parents of **Enzo** (a 10<sup>th</sup> grader saved last year) also came to know Jesus as their Lord and Savior. We are reaching out to our students' parents as well.

Unfortunately, our school has run out of space for any other enrolment. Eventually, I got a burden about the situation and decided to have a meeting with an engineer who attends our church and a Christian architect to see what we could do about it. We prayed together, and they designed the School Expansion Project, which I have attached to this prayer letter for you to see and pray for it.

Therefore, one of my goals while here in the U.S. is to raise \$75,000 for the Expansion Project to build the four classrooms that will enable us to enroll some 64 new students. We express our heartfelt words of gratitude to some churches that have already contributed to the Project in such a generous way. PRAISE THE LORD!

Please accept our gratitude for your faithful support. May the Lord greatly bless you.


