Evangelism Campaign



One of the highlights of the month is that we gained access to two schools (one private and one public). We attempted to reach two other schools but were unable to do so at the time. We preached to 13 different classrooms in these schools, targeting students aged 12-18. Please pray for us; we now have an open door in both schools, and I continue to visit them. Recently, I was asked to teach about "Creation and Evolution." I believe this open door presents an incredible opportunity for our ministry.

Another significant effort was street preaching, with our teenagers taking the lead in many of these evangelistic outings. Throughout the month, we distributed 3,100 Romans and gospel tracts and witnessed to 591 people in both schools and streets; among them, 157 made professions of faith. Eighteen of them attended church. Now, the task is to follow up on these professions of faith and see if those who claim to be new converts show signs of genuine conversion. I pray we can witness some authentic fruit from these efforts.

Prayer Requests:

- Follow-up on prospects.
- Evangelism efforts in Mata Bonita and Bible Study soon to begin.
- Continuation of teaching and preaching in the schools.
- Pamela and the Baby's Health.

We also commenced evangelizing in Mata Bonita (the town we are considering for the next church plant). Since January, twelve individuals from this community have visited the church in Nagua. We are currently praying for a contact to initiate Bible studies in a home. Pray alongside us that someone would offer their home for these Bible studies.

Santo Domingo Trip

Throughout the past year, we organized a "healthy" competition. Those who memorized our weekly Bible verse without missing a week were invited to an activity outside of town. I am grateful for those who dedicated themselves to memorizing the Bible faithfully and diligently. Although the competition is no longer ongoing this year, we observe the same dedication to Bible memorization among the brethren, which brings us joy in this small accomplishment.



Baby Update

We are excited that Pam was released from bed rest toward the end of January. She still has some restrictions but can mostly resume normal activities with ministry and at home. She is 17 weeks along, bringing us closer to the halfway mark. We also learned that we are expecting a **baby boy**. We can't wait to meet this little answer to our prayers in a few short months.
